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Pad-Ready Site Work Starts at I-24 Business Park in Cadiz, Kentucky

Cadiz, Kentucky – Development work commenced last week on a 15 acre, pad-ready site at the I-24 Business Park in Cadiz, Kentucky. Located less than one mile from Interstate 24 at Exit 65, the 15 acre, pad-ready site is only 90 minutes from the Nashville International Airport.

The building could have a minimum size of 50,000 square-feet, expandable to 150,000 square-feet. The tract will be graded to include the area of the proposed building and any proposed expansion.
